

## FROM THE DIRECTOR’S DESK: How Many More?

It’s a legitimate question. This month we celebrate America’s 244<sup>th</sup> birthday. But for the last dozen or so, people have been given cause to wonder how many more we will commemorate as a free nation of the people, by the people, and for the people. Benjamin Franklin’s famous quote of “A republic, if you can keep it,” in response to the question, what kind of country did you (the founders) give us, keeps coming to mind since Barack Hussein Obama resolutely told those who were about to elect him in 2008 that they would soon be witnessing the fundamental transformation of our country. Even more ominous was Michelle Obama’s quote five months prior to that when she said “We are going to have to change our conversation; we’re going to have to change our traditions, our history; we’re going to have to move into a different place as a nation.”

# America's Christian Heritage

## Part I – Initial Historical Evidence

Of the many influences that shaped the United States of America into a wholly distinct and exceptional nation, none is more fundamental and enduring than that derived from the Bible. Deep Christian beliefs stemming from the Old and New Testaments were the foremost stimuli in the hearts of the settlers of America (1607-1774). The exhibition of their bravery and faith was demonstrative of a people guided by the Holy Spirit and enlightened with God's very words from scripture. "The shared belief of these freedom-seeking Christians set the foundation of an unsinkable spirit of nationhood, firmly instilled in them and handed to generations yet unborn" (President Ronald Reagan 1983).

Biblical knowledge also formed the basis of the "Founder's beliefs" (1774-1789) that our "unalienable rights" come FROM God, not from government. Second in importance to educated English Christians was their knowledge of the English Constitution and system of law and rights of Englishmen wherever they lived. They claimed birthrights from the Magna Carta (1215) to their Bill of Rights (1689). What the Settlers brought to America, the Founders incorporated into the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution with its own Bill of Rights. Many of America's Founders also knew verbatim America's Magna Carta – The Mayflower Compact.

Many of America's most recognized National leaders, including most Presidents, have acknowledged publicly the beneficial influence of God's words in the Bible, upon the collective American spirit – the spirit that birthed and nurtured American exceptionalism. Long ago, President Andrew Jackson said of our Biblical heritage, "The rock on which our republic rests."

Today, America is again facing challenges and dangers as great as those faced by our Founders. We need God's Providential blessings more than technology and armaments. With the nation in great distress and war, President Abraham Lincoln said of the Bible, "... the best gift God has ever given ... but for it, we could not know right from wrong."

The only man deservedly called, "The Father of Our Country," George Washington said in his first Inaugural Address (1789), "It would be improper to omit ... fervent supplications to that Almighty Being who rules the universe ... we ought to be persuaded that the propitious smiles of heaven can never be expected on a nation that disregards the eternal rules of order and right which heaven itself has ordained." He found those eternal rules in his Bible.

Upon Washington's departure from public service, he gave a Farewell Address (1796) wherein he warned Americans to "never undermine Christianity or morality which are indispensable supports for America's political prosperity."

Do the foregoing quotations establish a foundation of an American exceptionalism? Are these beliefs that which caused thousands to abandon their homes for America? – many risking their lives. There is one undeniable certainty: the right to worship without fear, with an uncoerced conscience, was the foremost single impetus for the settling of wilderness America – a direct outgrowth of well-understood Biblical Christianity.

Americans do well to remember Washington's words since so many have been lulled to sleep with prosperity, sports, and entertainment, becoming idle and indifferent so that malignant social and political dangers from radical secularism to murderous Islam stand ready to fill any gap left by a compromised Christianity and a deserted patriotism. The first antitoxin for this malady is prayer, then to restore education to its proper place. Real history teaches what happens in Christian nations that forget God. Germany and Russia were subverted into deadly socialist nightmares where millions were murdered.

Our fourth President and a key Founding Father, James Madison noted, "nations are most likely to fall from within through ever encroaching usurpation of power (witness the Deep State machinations in the FBI). By the 1770's, Colonial America began to experience an increasing loss of freedom by unconstitutional acts of a Parliament 3,000 miles away and a King indifferent to the pleadings of his loyal American subjects.

Benjamin Franklin, one of America's most beloved Founders warned, "Those, who would give up essential liberty [for] temporary safety deserve neither liberty nor safety." A twentieth century English leader perhaps borrowed from Franklin. He said, "If you will not fight when you can win, you may have to fight when winning is in doubt. If you still hesitate, you may be forced to fight when you cannot win since it is better to fight and die as a free people than to live as slaves" (Winston Churchill during World War II).

America is plagued in our universities with radical left-wing secularist professors and the purveyors of "revisionist history." They turn out their clones into various "NEWS" organizations where they manufacture their brand of yellow journalism now known better as "fake news." These professorial polluters of children's minds have unleashed upon us maniacal masked Marxists called "Antifa" who riot, smash windows, and set fires.

When our community activist President Obama declared in Europe that America was not a Christian nation, he forgot he also said that, "Americans cling to their guns and their Bibles." Nearly all other Presidents publicly acknowledged that America's greatness was and is a direct result of Christianity. They, like our Founders also did, "Cling to their guns and Bibles and the God who grants 'unalienable rights.'"

So, if we are living on a "borrowed legacy," it is comforting to know the legacy is still there. Our origins, though despised and ignored by some university professors, is unchanged and we are still "one nation under God" where children are free to recite these words and, God willing, they always will.

The late Senator John McCain was severely castigated during his run for President (2007) when he said America was founded on Christian principles. He was criticized by Ira Forman of the National Jewish Democratic Council, but Jewish conservative columnist Don Feder countered with, "Nowhere does the Constitution say there is a wall of separation of church and state." What Forman forgot is that non-factual revisionist history does poorly in the presence of confirmed facts and verifiable history.

Rabbi Daniel Lapin, an orthodox Jewish teacher and leader defended the concept of a Christian America. Rabbi Lapin pointed to the protection given to Jewish people in the United States of America. The Rabbi reported, "No nation has provided the same haven of tranquility and prosperity for

Jews as has the United States AND this is NOT in spite of America being Christian; it is BECAUSE of it. You might say America's Bible belt is the Jewish Community's "safety belt." Rabbi Lapin warned that the safety of all Americans, not just Jews, is put at risk when Christian Faith is attacked in universities and undermined in straying seminaries.

For those who chafe at the fact that America began as a Christian nation just need to look at real history. In the 1970's, "The Encyclopedia Britannica" produced a set of columns called "The Annals of America" which contains writings from American history. These provide indisputable facts that America had a Christian beginning, especially the writings of America's Founders, in their own words. God and the Christian Faith AND the Bible are that which founded America.

Why did Christian nations such as Germany and Russia abandon their national faith for the nightmare of socialism and fall into such misery, but America has not? It may be for no other reason than our support of Israel and our judicious dealings with Jewish Americans. Our Bible tells us of God's word to Abraham, "I will bless them that bless thee and curse them that curse thee" (Gen. 12:3). God raised up gentiles to bless Israel such as Cyrus of Persia, Hiram of Lebanon, and others to bless Israel. When God, in 1948, fulfilled His ancient promises and prophecies to return Israel to the land promised them, President Harry S. Truman was the first national leader to recognize their right to their homeland.

God providentially prepared a haven in wilderness America for persecuted English Christians who settled first in 1607 Virginia, then in Plymouth, Massachusetts in 1620. Thousands followed, all carrying their Bibles and they based their lives and their laws and doctrines upon its precepts.

Our present form of governance still rests upon our Founding Documents that clearly acknowledge God which for the Settlers was the Mayflower Compact and the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution with the Bill of Rights for the Founders. Christianity had a commanding role in the spirit of our nation from 1607 to 1789 because the people demanded it and God blessed it.

As America's greatest general and President George Washington said, "Christianity and morality are indispensable to our prosperity." May the Spirit of God raise up Christian prayer warriors to humbly seek His continued blessing upon America. Keep looking up.

Psalm 12:6 – *“The words of the Lord are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times.”*

Psalm 119:11 – *“Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against Thee.”*

Matthew 5:8 – *“Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.”*

1 Cor. 5:11 – *“But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat.”*

Col. 3:15 – *“And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.”*

James 1:27 – *“Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, to visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world.”*

1 Peter 2:11 – *“Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul.”*

1 John 2:16 – *“For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.”*

Over the past several months, we have been exploring some of the attributes of God, from the perspective of the Bible, and I pray these articles have been helping in strengthening each of our testimonies to the glory of God.

To reiterate, the purpose of the Christian life is to glorify the Lord in the path He’s set before us, and to be pliable clay in the hands of the Master Potter, in order to be conformed to His character.

This month I’d like to probe into yet another of God’s characteristics, that being purity. The dictionary defines **pure** as *“free from contact with that which weakens, impairs, pollutes; that which contains nothing inappropriate, devoid of impurities; clean.”*

We, as believers have been exhorted to *“keep ourselves unspotted from the world”* (James 1:27). How though, can this be done? What is the key to being pure, while at the same time, living in a world that is so very far from it? Scripture tells us that *“these words of the Lord are*

*pure words; as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times*" (Psalm 12:6). God's Word is precious and is of great value. God's Word is sincere and is truth, and has no other design toward us than for our own good! This is one reason, I believe, we've been exhorted to *"hide God's Word in our hearts"* (Psalm 119:11a). It's a fortress, a stronghold into which God desires to keep us.


Jesus taught the multitudes that *"the pure in heart shall see God"* (Matt. 5:8). Only the blood of Jesus Christ is able to cleanse us from all unrighteousness and sin. A heart that is free from sin is pure! Those who have been cleansed, and are now free from the penalty of sin, show themselves to be under the power of the *"pure and undefiled religion"*, and endeavor to keep themselves from carnal desires which war against the soul and adversely affect the Christian life (1 Peter 2:11). Fleshly lusts debilitate the soul and rob it of its comfort and peace. Carnal appetites are destructive to man's spirit.

As obedient children, we are cautioned not to conform to the behavior that used to be, before we knew better. We are to live our lives revealing that there has been a transformation from the inside, from our core, from the heart!! God not only brings us hope, but His Word also leads to our obedience. The Christian's sanctification is a continuous process. The Lord calls the believer to be holy, or set apart. Praise God we have Jesus Christ who is our perfect model for holiness!

Paul admonishes us Christians to put Christ first in our lives, to please Him in all things. Focus on the Lord, and what He would have us to do. Acquaint ourselves, and train our desires toward heavenly things, to be spiritually minded: because it is only God's Holy Spirit, not any strength of our own, who will bring purity to our lives. He will keep us from the lusts of the flesh, the lusts of the eyes, and the pride of life (1 John 2:16). That's a promise!!!

The impure church is an ineffective church, but a pure church is a powerful church! The apostle Paul addresses this in 1 Cor. 5:11. As Christians we are set apart to be used of God. We are, as believers, united with Christ. The Holy Spirit is working in our lives to produce His peace, His holiness, and His purity, to govern us and make a **difference** in us. It is our duty to be at peace with one another (Rom. 12:18). We should be so thankful for the peace that only God can give, that it would cause us to be more pleasant to all those with whom we come in contact ..... no matter what is going on in the world around us! The more gratefulness is developed, the more peaceful we are, and the more pure our hearts become (Col. 3:15).

# Judge Not and the Truth Will Set You Free

The secular world is very skilled at finding Bible verses that they can pervert and use to advance their sinful agendas. Oh, I forgot, it's politically incorrect to talk about sin. The discovery that morals are relative has rendered sin an arbitrary concept.

Moral relativism is based on the idea that the Bible instructs people not to judge one another. Depending on your Bible version, Matthew 7 does indeed start off with the words, "Judge not, that ye be not judged." But stopping the verse there and ignoring the true message that follows is a lie. Jesus identified, i.e. "judged," adultery as a sin, but chose to extend grace to the sinner. The fact that Jesus saved the life of a woman is no small matter to ignore either.

In John 8:32 we find another verse that has been watered down to the point of missing the point. The world has turned the phrase "the truth will set you free" into a cliché. The actual verse is a conditional statement: If this, then this.

Verse 31: To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. 32 **Then** you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." When chapters seven and eight of John's gospel are read together and in context, it becomes clear that the message is defining who Jesus is. The conclusion of chapter eight even has Jesus referring to Himself as "**I AM**." That reference stirred the Pharisees to want to stone Him on the spot.

In this world the truth does not always set people free or correct past sins. Here's a case in point. In 1955, Carolyn Bryant Donham falsely accused Emmett Till of sexual harassment. "That lie led to Till being beaten beyond recognition, shot in the head, having his eyes gouged out and a 74-pound cotton gin fan tied to his neck with barbed wire before being thrown in the nearby Tallahatchie River. The murder—and the gruesome images of his open-casket funeral published in Jet magazine—catalyzed the civil rights movement in the 1960s. ([The\\_Undefeated.com](http://The_Undefeated.com)\_01-13-2017); Donham finally admitted in 2007 that she had lied, but the truth did not and will never set the fourteen year old boy free from his death sentence.

It is the truth about Jesus that will set you free—free spiritually. Understanding that He was God incarnate is an imperative building block to the Christian faith. His atonement for your sins would be meaningless without it. Stand up for the truth the next time you hear the world turn scripture into meaningless secular clichés. There is no sin in fighting against moral relativism; only sin in not doing so,

# Rumblings of an Impending Storm

Underlying this commentary is the unchallenged truth that God is sovereign. Despite the claims of political leaders and tyrannical despots around the world, and throughout history, man is not in control. God always has been and always will be in charge. Gradually, over the years I have had an uneasy sense about America. Many, if not most, of the aspects of American society and culture that seemed to provide stability in the past could no longer be relied upon. All is not well with the America in which I grew up.

## **MICHAEL ANTHONY PEROUTKA: “WE LIVE IN DANGEROUS TIMES.”**

It seems as if we have been moving through a “perpetual state of emergency” (John Whitehead). It started with 9/11, which led to the ongoing terrorist wars. Then we experienced the COVID-19 lockdowns along with an unparalleled economic disaster in which 47 million people filed for unemployment over a 14-week period. This country was a tinderbox, and the match that set it afire was the killing of a black man by a white police officer. The result was an explosion of protests, riots, property destruction, fires and looting in as many as 75 cities. People were injured and some were killed. Most of the rioters have been lawless mobs seeking to destroy “everything that stands for law and order” (Leo Hohmann).

We are watching “political theater and public spectacle,” John Whitehead says of the riots, but Michael Peroutka warns this is “a distraction from what is really going on.” When the anarchists take over as they did in downtown Seattle, “they want to be the law, be their own police.” Then the “thugs and warlords” will fill the void and be “boss.”

## **RON PAUL: “I’M TRULY STARTING TO WORRY ABOUT THIS GATHERING STORM.”**

Many of those writing about these events taking place believe we are heading for either all-out martial law or totalitarianism. John Whitehead believes “the protestors are playing right into the government’s hands because they want an excuse to lock down the nation” and set up martial law. Michael Peroutka states that this has been a “trial run to see what tactics would work to control people.”

Although the protests continue, our liberty is also at stake with the push toward forced vaccinations and contact tracing, both of which are on the horizon. Barbara Loe Fisher, affiliated with the National Vaccine Information Center, wrote an analysis on Dr. Joseph Mercola’s website, in which she stated, “If the state can tag, track down and force individuals to be injected with biologicals of known and unknown toxicity today, there will be no limit on which individual freedoms the state can take away in the name of the greater good tomorrow.” The premise has been “the price of safety is liberty.”

Ron Paul, chairman of Campaign for Liberty, has sent out numerous e-mail messages in recent weeks urging citizens to contact their Congressional representatives to oppose H.R. 6666 (TRACE Act) which “creates a Stasi-style police force with power to enter your home to ‘conduct testing,’ ‘contact tracing’ . . . and for ‘other purposes’ to separate those who test positive (or refuse to comply) from loved ones!” Dr. Paul states, “Coronavirus DOES NOT give government license to trample our liberties.”

There are other disturbing aspects that indicate “America is literally coming apart at the seams,” according to Michael Snyder in his Economic Collapse Blog. Tom DeWeese of the American Policy Center states, “We are living in the most dangerous time in American history . . . Contact tracing is one of the most concentrated attacks on our American liberty.”

The ongoing defacing, toppling and burning of our statues destroy our history as a nation, especially our beginnings. Derrick Gilbert of SkywatchTV stated on 6/17/2020 that “symbols of anything American is being targeted, not just slave-holders.” This is about “destroying the history of Western civilization.” Michael Peroutka stated that the toppling of statues is Nazi behavior.

Leo Hohman in his posting in Technocracy News & Trends on 6/16/2020 considers the actions of these mobs as “textbook revolutionary tactics.” He warns that if what happened in Seattle with their autonomous zone take-over begins to happen in other cities, we could be on the brink of a revolution that may lead to “the 2nd American Civil War.”

Minneapolis now has a ‘Mutual Aid Autonomous Zone’ with encampments in the Twin-Cities area, but it is referred to as “non-police/non-government folks on the south side.” Mobs tried to set up autonomous zones in Portland, Nashville, Ashville and Chicago, but these were dismantled by local police. More recent attempts have been made in Washington DC.

The activist mobs affiliated with Black Lives Matter and Antifa are fighting against what most traditional Americans value. BLM displays on their website “the communist clenched fist.” Their goal is to disrupt the Western nuclear family and set up “a neo-Marxist utopian idea of collectivism with strictly regulated speech and no freedom of religion or right to bear arms” (Leo Hohmann). Traditional America values God, strong families, individual freedom and private property rights found in our U.S. Constitution.

We may have arrived at this point in the history of our country, in part, because we have turned our backs on God and systematically eliminated him from our national life, including our schools and public places. Some churches preach the social gospel instead of the true gospel of salvation in Jesus Christ.

We sent our children to public schools and universities where they were taught the ways of the world including, evolution, socialism and even Marxism. Over the years many of our children turned away from the traditions of our American heritage. They grew up accepting abortion as if it were the law of the land, and more recently they were told by the Supreme Court that same-sex marriage was also “legal.”

David Kupelian, vice president and managing editor of World Net Daily, stated, “In reality, as I document in the book (*The Snapping of the American Mind*), the socialist/Marxist ideology that has captivated today’s Democrat Party, our culture and our universities is at total war with reason, human nature, common sense, economics, history and truth—indeed, at war with God and His Laws.”
