

America's Christian Heritage Part III – God Blesses a Praying Nation

“Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people” (Proverbs 14:34). The only opinion that is worth following and that really matters is God’s. His words are of the “good seed” of any peoples’ wisdom and understanding (Matt. 13:23).

The Bible points to only ONE “chosen nation” and people, and these are the natural blood descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. These descendants from Abraham were appointed by God to be governed by theocratic rule; first under Moses and then Joshua in the wilderness; then by Judges until they demanded a king during the judgeship of Samuel. God granted their request but warned through Samuel, how oppressive human kings would be due to all mankind’s inherited depraved nature (1 Sam. 8:1-22; Ep. 2:23). Absolute power corrupts absolutely: always did, always will. Even so, God heard the prayers of His chosen people in times of national distress and answered by raising up types of the coming Deliverer, Joseph, Moses, David, and others.

Later, when certain captives from Jerusalem, who were exiled to Babylon, were required to worship Nebuchadnezzar’s golden image (a sin against God) several refused. For that they were threatened with death (Dan. 3:1-7). They engaged in a God-honoring use of peaceful civil disobedience (8-12). The furious King cast Daniel’s friends into a fiery furnace (13-25). God then miraculously saved them by sending “one like the Son of man” to protect them (26-30). Still later, Daniel was similarly delivered from death in a lion’s den (Dan. 6:7-10).

Centuries later the Sanhedrin ordered Peter and John to cease preaching about Jesus Christ and Peter announced, “We must obey God rather than men” (Acts 5:29). They too realized that God’s opinion and command is that which matters most.

This truth applies even when rulers claim to be in obedience to God as when “Bloody Mary” in 16th Century England had Christians burned alive. In “Foxes Book of Martyrs” innocents received torture and death mostly from those “professing” allegiance to Christ Jesus; it was another Jesus (2 Cor. 11:4).

In this time of darkness in England (16th & 17th centuries) many were already desirous of a refuge where freedom of worship and benevolent, enlightened leadership might exist. Christians know they are commanded to obey rulers even under minor sufferings (excessive taxation, etc.- Mark 12:15-17). They also know that God raises up kings (Ps. 75:7; Dan. 2:21) turning their hearts to His will AND that His will is that rulers are to be a terror to the evil, NOT to the good (Rom. 13:3-4). God hears the prayers of His oppressed children – a singular consolation.

Faithfully following God’s truth in scripture was the main element of the genius exhibited by the Settlers and Founders of America’s unequalled Constitutional form of government. It is apparent that the Lord’s seed fell on good ground in America (Mark 4:20).

Our Founders were also educated in their own English history and knew the pitfalls of autocratic rule. John Adams, our second President said, “Any man holding unchecked political power is a ravenous bird of prey.” Executive, legislative, and judicial power must each be contained and balanced by other governmental powers for freedom to endure.

Both the Bible and historical accounts show that some autocrats had tried to force Christians to disobey God's commands. When Pagan Rome ruled an Empire, they were sometimes satisfied with insincere outward shows of obedience. Citizens could worship any god, even Jesus, provided they ALSO worshipped Caesar (Christians could not); those who refused were punished and many lost their lives. God has at times raised up evil men (Rom. 9:17; Ex. 9: 16) but their willful sins and responsibility is theirs. God is eternally, perfectly holy – He cannot sin (Ex. 9:13-16; Rom. 9:17-18; Gen. 45:4-8, 50:20; John 19:11; Acts 2:22-23; Rom. 13:1-5).

Our loving merciful Father hears our prayers and also raises up benevolent leaders, and this He did throughout America's settling and Founding periods. In time, there came one man particularly well suited to lead. He was a well-taught fervent Christian raised by God to be the Father of the American Nation – George Washington. His father, Augustine, was a moderately wealthy landowner and elder in the Anglican Church. George Washington's two elder brothers (from Augustine's first marriage to Jane Butler) had both received superior private school education in England and became George's tutors (he was primarily home schooled). He was even more blessed by his mother (Augustine's second wife) Mary Ball. Mary was a woman of uncommon wisdom, kindness, and unwavering virtue and when necessary her word was law.

Upon Augustine's death (George was only eleven), he became the male authority figure to his five younger siblings. This and the fact that he was unusually tall (six foot, four inches as an adult) contributed to his future leadership roles for his nation.

Many instances in his life molded him for greatness but only a few can be mentioned. As a young officer over an American militia unit that was attached to Gen. Braddock's British unit, they fell into an ambush by French and Indian enemies. Every British officer was killed or wounded and nearly half the soldiers. Washington had several horses shot out from under him, had four bullet holes in his coat, and the testimony of the enemy Indian Chief was that the “Great Spirit” was with Washington since he had pointedly instructed his braves to concentrate their fire on him. The Chief, not a Christian, knew God protected Washington.

Later, during the War for Independence, Washington and his whole army were trapped by vastly superior British forces on Brooklyn Heights in New York. At his back was the water of the inlet. The sun was about to set, so the British decided to have their victory and celebration the next day – a common maneuver in that era in military conflicts.

God, who “governs in the affairs of men,” just then rolled in a dense fog. Washington seized this providential blessing and had his men work in almost miraculous silence, crossing the inlet on barges, rafts, small boats, and canoes. His troops worked all night, crossing and re-crossing with ALL men, materials, horses, and weaponry. Sometime after daybreak, the fog lifted, and the British saw their certain victory and their quarry vanished.

Some believe the exceptionalism of the United States of America is rooted in the many similar past providential blessings and acts of God on our behalf. If so, it is another reason to

glorify our Creator – the Lord Jesus Christ (John 1:1-3; Ep. 3:9; Col. 1:16; Heb. 1:1-2).

Even God's providential acts, before any English had come to America, prepared the way. In the 1500's, Spain launched a huge Armada to invade England, and deal death and destruction to Queen Elizabeth and the nation. Besides the Queen, the Puritans and dissenters from Papal authority were particularly slated for extermination. This savagery was sanctioned by the Pope and the King of Spain. No apology has ever been given.

Providence sent a storm so devastating upon that Armada that Spanish ships, men, and materials, were scattered in the English Channel and the North Sea. Not one of the thousands of Spanish soldiers set foot on English soil. Had God not spared the Puritans, their grandchildren would not have come to America.

During our colonial period (when England and France were at war) France lost Nova Scotia to Britain. Seeking revenge, France outfitted a large Armada to sail to America intent on setting fire to every English town and village from New England to Georgia. America had no professional Army or Navy to stop them.

This Armada was besieged by storms even in France and when finally, at sea, worse storms arose. Meantime, Americans were daily gathering in prayer asking God to prevent their slaughter. The French vessels were hit with even more violent storms and several went down. Others were filled with sickened men and many were buried every day at sea. Soon after making shore, the Admiral died, and the Vice Admiral committed suicide. They sailed home never having fired a shot.

The "starving time" at Jamestown and their decision to return to England was only halted when on the very day of their departure, a ship commanded by Lord De la Warr (later Delaware) appeared with new settlers, food, and supplies. The Colony was saved. The colonists, looking back declared, "God's providential intervention kept us a colony."

It was the success of Jamestown that encouraged a small group of separated (2 Cor. 6:13-17) Puritan Christians to set sail for Virginia. Yet another providential storm from God drove their ship north to Plymouth, Mass. In spite of fabrications of "radical revisionist historians," the Pilgrims and Puritans were a literate people, some university educated. They committed themselves to a "pure" form of Reformation Christianity derived from their Geneva Bibles and knew of God's "perfect law of liberty" (Luke 4:18; Rom. 8:21; James 1:25, 2:12).

These persecuted Christians populated the "New World." Both their trust in God and His Word set the tone for "One nation under God, indivisible with liberty and justice for all." Their Christian spirit and faithfulness were unfolded in the Mayflower Compact, the Declaration of Independence, the thirteen Colonial Charters, the State Constitutions, and finally in the Constitution of the United States of America.

Our country is worth fighting for, dying for, and certainly worth praying for. God Bless America. Keep looking up (Luke 21:28).

MEDICAL TYRANNY

“Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life; and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.” Psalm 23:6

America will soon be moving well beyond lockdowns, mandated mask-wearing, social distancing and testing for COVID-19 to a much darker scenario. According to Michael Peroutka, all of this is “part of a larger agenda.” Mr. Peroutka indicated “medical martial law is taking precedence over the Constitution and over the authority of churches and of families.”

On July 30, 2020 Barry Norris authored an article entitled, “The Biggest Fraud Ever, Part 1: The Hocus ‘Science’ Behind Lockdowns. ” In a remarkably revealing chart he shows that of the 13 pandemics throughout history COVID-19 currently ranks tenth in its mortality rate. The pandemics with higher mortality rates include, Smallpox, Black Death, Spanish Flu, HIV/AIDS, Cholera, and three other types of flu. Only three other pandemics have lower mortality rates than COVID-19: Ebola, MERS, and SARS (ZeroHedge).

Dr. Joseph Mercola maintains that “lethality from COVID-19 has been massively overestimated.” In an article entitled, “Consistent Inaccuracies in COVID-19 Testing and Reporting” he states, “An overall mortality rate of 0.1% is right in line with statistics cited by Stanford University’s disease prevention chairman, Dr. John Ioannidis, as well.” In a June 27, 2020 interview with Greek Reporter Dr. Ioannidis said: “0.05% to 1% is a reasonable range for what the data tell us now for the infection fatality rate, with a median of about 0.25%. For people younger than 45, the infection fatality rate is almost 0%. For 45 to 70, it is probably about 0.05-0.3%” (Mercola.com, 7/27/2020).

According to John Sanders, chief of infectious diseases at Wake Forest Baptist Health, “We can . . . say the death rate is lower than we have estimated. The severity of symptoms is lower than we estimated and the vast majority of people who were infected are going to do just fine.” (Mercola.com).

In an e-mail message from Pastor Chuck Baldwin entitled, “CDC Admits to Remarkably Low Coronavirus Death Rate,” he states, “For the first time, the CDC has attempted to offer a real estimate of the overall death rate for COVID-19, and under its most likely scenario, the number is 0.26%.” In this same message, a registered nurse with 30 years of experience, who worked primarily in infection control, commented, “COVID-19 testing is completely flawed and the case and death rates are grossly distorted” ... “current recommendations” are “ridiculous” (8/13/2020).

Almost from the beginning of this pandemic there have been major problems with COVID-19 testing and reporting results. Dr. Mercola stated, “Faulty or contaminated tests have been used and reporting guidelines have been changed and updated multiple times, virtually eliminating any possibility of accurately tracking infected cases and deaths.” Some states and some labs only report positive test results instead of including all results. “Continued testing also leads to irrational fear mongering based on a combination of wildly manipulated data and flawed tests,” stated Dr. Mercola.

On August 13th, an article appeared in Technocracy News & Trends, entitled, "Nursing Homes Shocked at Insanely Wrong COVID-19 Data." One example among many is the Dellridge Health and Rehabilitation Center in Paramus, New Jersey. The CMS data indicated that 753 people had died in that nursing home. Jonathan Mechaly, marketing director, wrote in a frantic email, "We are a 90-bed center and have had less than 20 deaths!! How do you report such inaccurate numbers?"

An increasing number of doctors and medical professionals are writing about the effectiveness and safety of face masks. On August 10th Technocracy News & Trends had an article entitled, "Europe's Top Health Officials Say Masks Aren't Helpful in Beating COVID-19." Recently, Danish health officials noted "there is little conclusive evidence that face masks are an effective way to limit the spread of respiratory viruses." The author noted that data show 80-90% of people in Finland and Holland say they "never wear masks." Dutch public health officials recently explained why they are not recommending masks: "From a medical point of view, there is no evidence of a medical effect of wearing face masks, so we decided not to impose a national obligation," said Medical Care Minister Tamara van Ark (posted by Jon Miltimore via Fee).

Sweden's lead epidemiologist, Dr. Anders Tengell, warned that telling people to wear face masks is "very dangerous" because it gives a false sense of security, but does not effectively stem the spread of the virus. "The findings that have been produced through face masks are astonishingly weak." Dr. Tengell is surprised there are not "more or better studies showing the effects masks actually have." He oversaw Sweden's response to coronavirus by resisting any form of lockdown or mask mandate. Sweden's cases and deaths have slowed to a trickle and were lower than in Spain, UK, Italy and Belgium, all of whom imposed lockdowns and mandated masks (ZeroHedge, 8/21/2020, Steve Watson via Summit News).

On May 21, 2020 The New England Journal of Medicine stated that masks provide little or no protection from infection (Michael A. Peroutka, 7/16/2020).

Dr. Colleen Huber, NMD wrote an article entitled, "Masks are Neither Effective nor Safe: A Summary of the Science." Her review of peer-reviewed medical literature regarding the impacts of mask wearing on human health "show that masks serve more as instruments of obstruction of normal breathing, rather than as effective barriers to pathogens. Therefore, masks should not be used by the general public, either by adults or children" (Citizens for Free Speech, 7/15/2020).

In an article entitled, "Face Masks Pose Serious Risks to the Healthy," Russell Blaylock, MD warns that "not only do face masks fail to protect the healthy from getting sick, but they also create serious health risks to the wearer." The bottom line, according to Dr. Blaylock: "If you are not sick, you should not wear a face mask."

As for the scientific support for the use of a face mask, a recent careful examination of the literature, in which 17 of the best studies were analyzed, concluded that, "None of the studies establish a conclusive relationship between mask/respirator use and protection against influenza infection." The recommendation by the CDC and the WHO are not based on any studies of

the coronavirus, and masks have never been used to contain any other virus pandemic in history (Dr. Russell Blaylock).

What are the dangers of wearing face masks, especially for long periods? Studies found significant problems: headaches, increased airway resistance, carbon dioxide accumulation, hypoxia (reduced blood oxygenation) and a possible loss of consciousness. For those with lung disease, lung cancer or who have had lung surgery, mask-wearing can cause severe worsening of lung function (Dr. Blaylock).

When a person with a respiratory virus wears a mask, the exhaled virus will not be able to escape and it will concentrate in the nasal passages, enter the olfactory nerves and travel into the area of the brain dealing with recent memory and memory consolidation. (Dr. Blaylock)

Dr. Blaylock concludes that there is insufficient evidence that wearing a mask can have a significant impact in preventing the spread of this virus. It is a relatively benign infection for the vast majority of the population and most of the at-risk group will also survive. We should let this virus spread throughout the healthier population so we will reach a herd immunity level and end this pandemic quickly (Citizens for Free Speech, 5/11/2020).

There are numerous other articles from a variety of sources that substantiate the evidence and conclusions of these doctors and medical professionals. Michael Anthony Peroutka states, "So, it has more to do with our submission to the tyranny of those who rule over us and to reduce us to despotism" (7/30/2020).

On July 29th John W. Whitehead wrote an article in which he asked, "One Nation Under House Arrest: How Do COVID Mandates Impact our Freedoms?" He answered the question by stating, "We have become one nation under house arrest," and provided a shocking example to illustrate his point. Elizabeth Linscott lives in Kentucky and planned to visit her parents and grandparents in Michigan. She took the COVID-19 test as a precaution, and it came back positive. She was asymptomatic, but had no symptoms. Her husband, Isaiah, and infant daughter tested negative.

She was asked to sign a self-quarantine order agreeing to check in daily with the health department and not to travel anywhere without prior approval. She refused, and wrote her own declaration and stated that as an adult she could make her own decisions.

"A few days after being informed that Elizabeth's case was being escalated and referred to law enforcement, the Linscotts reportedly found their home surrounded by multiple government vehicles, government personnel and the county sheriff armed with a court order and ankle monitors." Isaiah and Elizabeth Linscott were fitted with ankle monitors.

John Whitehead states, "This is government tyranny in the name of national security. . . Whether or not you concede that the pandemic itself is cause for alarm, we should all be alarmed by the government's response to it." He concludes, "This is what we've all been reduced to: prisoners in our own skin, prisoners in our homes, prisoners in our communities—forced to comply with the government's shifting mandates about how to navigate this pandemic. . . or else.

**In God I have put my trust, I shall not be afraid. What can man do to me?”

Unless we begin to boldly speak the truth about this relatively benign virus with a very low mortality rate and stand up to political leaders on every level, we will be facing a very bleak future in a once free country. Why is this happening? What is really going on?

What's next? In the days ahead we will see screening checkpoints, contact tracing, forced vaccinations, digital control, Trust Stamps, immunity passports, snitch tip lines and the technocratic Great Reset.
